We came to Uganda with the vision of staying in Kampala for 5-10 years. I was to go through the pastoral internship at CCK and then become a campus pastor in one of the locations around the city. After 5-10 years we were going to go back to Canada to plant a church. In 2007 God spoke to me from Romans 14:20-21

"I make it my ambition to preach the gospel, not where Christ has already been named, lest I build on someone else's foundation, but as it is written, 'Those who have never been told of him will see, and those who have never heard will understand.'"

Since October, Kim and I have been praying about returning to Canada sooner, rather than later. God started closing doors here in Uganda, especially through finances. We thought that we should begin taking a step towards leaving. After several emails and phone-calls with people in Canada, along with talks with our pastors here, it became apparent that God was indeed leading us to Canada. Doors

began opening with everything from our personal needs to ministry opportunities. So we have decided to leave Uganda at the end of this month and return to the Niagara Region.

A second piece of good news is that Kim is pregnant. This is a huge miracle, as doctors told us that it would be impossible for Kim to ever conceive naturally again. We are so grateful for everything that God is doing for us as we speak. We feel a little bit like Peter, who accepted the unexpected (Jesus walking on water) and stepping out in faith, walked on water. We look forward to seeing you all again, and thank you so much for your support and prayers.
